

EU WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU – Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment

The European Union's WEEE directive regarding waste management is in effect since 13 August 2005 and amended on Oct 24 2015. The directive is applicable for European Union member states. The directive ensures that producers will provide the collection systems and the proper disposal and/or recycling of the applicable products.

All our medical device products delivered since 13 August 2005 are covered by the directive and as such are marked with the “Crossed Out Wheeled Bin” symbol. The symbol is located on the label and in the user manual of our products. As such our products disposed of should not be mixed with general household waste.


